How to claim your CME credits and ABIM MOC points:

1. **ASE Members:** Go to ASEcho.org and log into the Member Portal with your ASE member e-mail address and password.
 - a. Click on **ASEUniversity and CME Credits** (This will take you directly to your ASEUniversity profile)
2. **Nonmembers:** Go to ASEUniversity.org create a new account or log into your existing ASEUniversity account.
3. Once logged into ASEUniversity, the top of the page should say, "Hello, ____." Click **Your Account**.
4. Under **Your Account**, click on **Add Access Code** and enter the code, **REVIEW2017**
5. Verify your registration information. Please be sure to use the same information you used to register for the event.
6. Once verified, click **Take Evaluation** to claim your CME credit. CME credits are not earned until the entire evaluation has been completed.
7. Your certificate will be available for immediate download and can also be found under **Your Account** in the **CE Transcript**.

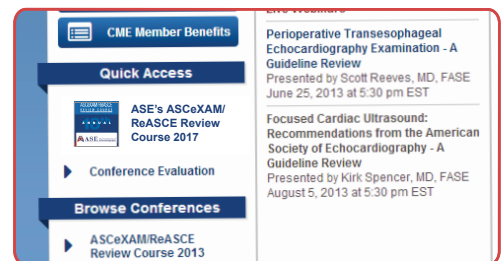
